Land and Buildings Asset Register

Drax PC owns three pieces of land in the village

The first two are small “wedges” of wooded land on Church Dyke Lane.

The first piece is on the right hand side leaving the Village. It starts immediately after the speed limit sign, and ends at the first field gate.

The second lies on the left hand side of the Lane, and starts 20yds from the speed limit sign, and ends at the cricket field gate.

The third piece of land comprises Drax Burial Ground on Hales Lane, adjacent to the Pumping Station. The land was bought from the Carlton Towers Estate late in 2012, following the closure of the Church Burial Ground to new burials. The land covers approximately one acre

Money was borrowed from the Public Works Loan Board; and the whole project is run in partnership with Newland Parish Council.

The Parish Council owns a laptop for use by the Council Clerk, as required by law.

The play equipment situated on the Village Field opposite the Village Hall was supplied by Drax Parish Council.

The Parish Council also owns the Queen's Commemorative bench, situated in the Civil Cemetery; and another bench outside the Village Hall.

There are also three Dog Waste bins within the Village.
